2. **To agree the Minutes of the last Parish Council Meeting:**

3. **North Yorkshire Council Report:** No Report.
4. **Clerk's Report:** A Resident contacted the Council to give thanks for organising the traffic controlling lights.
5. **General Parish Matters:** A deputy guardian for the defibrillator has not been found but the guardian in place is coping well.
6. **Highways:** The poles have been installed for the traffic controlling lights. One pole has to be re positioned. Councillor Bailey-Chapman is dealing with this.
